

Project Instructions

Blue Winter Trees Bowl

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What You'll Need:

Bisque	QTY
 Everyday Serving Bowl (Item 2133)	<input type="text"/>

Color	QTY	Size
 Polar Bear (Item 2300)	<input type="text"/>	Pint <input type="button" value="v"/>
 Teal Tomorrow (Item 2310)	<input type="text"/>	Pint <input type="button" value="v"/>

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Instructions:

Step 1 – Apply 3 coats of Polar Bear to the bowl. Use a sponge for your 3rd coat.

Step 2 – Next, trace the “sloping snowy hills” bottom portion of your template onto your bowl. You will trace the trees later in the project.

Step 3 – Using Jumpin’ Juniper, Teal We Meet Again, and Teal Tomorrow, sponge on from the top of the hills up to the top of the bowl (light to dark) with the 3 colors. As you change colors, blend them together by using two colors on your sponge at once - this creates the ombre look.

Step 4 – Trace the “tree” portion of your pattern onto the bowl. If you would rather not use the pattern, you can freehand the trees as they are simple, flowing, and organic.

Step 5 – While the paint is still damp, use your toothpick to etch through the blue paint on your pattern, creating your trees and branches. Note: Etch only deep enough to where it reveals the white paint (Polar Bear) underneath. Try not to etch all the way down to the bisque.

Step 6 – Use a damp sponge to clean/wipe the bottom of the bowl where the blue may have overlapped the hills (snowy area). Using Snowstorm, apply one coat to the snow area, and feel free to splatter some as well to give it some snowy texture.

Dip it into Clear Glaze and fire to cone 06.
